Domestic violence data visualization 2023. Now you see.

Schitaetsya — project that raises awareness of domestic violence in Kazakhstan and tracks data on these kinds of cases for the public, journalists and activists. But dry numbers cannot cause emotions. To increase attention to the problem and to help people understand the data we created a visual style that clarifies the scale of the problem.

We set ourselves the goal to publish visual data every year at the beginning of March. This is the period when society is more focused on women's issues. For example: our images become rally posters during marches and in the period of feminist movement activity, when they publish our visual statistics on their Social Media, where we reach thousands of women, activists and journalists.



51% of women kept silent about domestic abuse from their partners.


Of those who reported the violence: 8% told the police, and only 3% informed the doctor.
